REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The NACAE Scholarship application form with all sections is to be completed by the student and submitted by the deadline date.

- One letter of recommendation from an instructor/teacher, outlining the applicant's potential for future professional contributions to the Hispanic Community. (The original letter of recommendation should be submitted in a sealed envelope, signed on the flap by its author.)
- A typed essay of 300-words or less, written in Spanish by the student, that reflects his/her qualifications and potential for leadership in the Hispanic Community, and states how the applicant plans to promote his/her Cuban cultural values and the Spanish Language.
- Resume is to include earned certificates, awards, and special honors.
- An official transcript from his/her high school. *Academic excellence (minimum GPA of 3.5).
- An estimate of educational expenses, including any other financial aid requested to start his/her college education.
